< Voting date every three years on the third Wednesday of March / s.5

> Election committee provides a report to the Council within 30 days after the election, including the report from the chief returning officer, setting out the results of the election and the election process / s.23(5)

> Preliminary voters list made available at least 30 days before voting date / s.37

> Official voters list made available at least 7 days before the voting date / s.38

> Citizens submit candidacy forms no later than 42 calendar days before the voting date / s.44(1)(b)

> Chief returning officer gives notice of a vote at least 40 days before the voting date / s.52(1)

> Mail-in voting packages mailed at least 34 days before the voting date to voters whose address of record is not within the Yukon, or at least 31 days before the voting date to voters whose address of record is within the Yukon / s.74(2)

> Voters may apply for a special ballot from 30 days before the voting date / s.83

> Applications for a judicial recount to the Judicial Council made not later than noon on the Monday following the voting date / s.143(1)

> Voters may appeal the results of the election to the Judicial Council within fourteen consecutive days after the close of the vote on the voting date / s.159(1)
