

KWANLIN DÜN FIRST NATION COUNCIL ELECTION ANNOUNCED

The writ of election was issued today by the Kwanlin Dün First Nation (KDFN) Council for a general election to be held on Wednesday, March 15, 2017. Kwanlin Dün citizens who are 18 years old on election day and eligible to vote will elect a new Council including a Chief and six Councillors as specified in the Kwanlin Dün First Nation *Election Act*.

KDFN Citizens interested in running for office must obtain the required Nomination Form and complete a Criminal Record Check.

The Nomination Period is from January 10, 2017 to February 1, 2017. For prospective candidates a completed Nomination Form and the Criminal Record Check must be provided in person to the Chief Returning Officer by 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, February 1, 2017.

The Election Office is located at **4 O'Brien Place, Whitehorse, YT**. The Election Office will be open for the Nomination Period as of January 11, 2017 on:

Mondays from 4pm – 6pm
Wednesdays from 4pm – 6pm
Thursdays from 3pm-4:30pm

The final day of the Nomination Period, February 1, 2017, the Election Office will be open from 1pm-5pm.

Citizens are encouraged to drop by the Election Office with any questions for the Chief Returning Officer. You may also book an appointment with the Chief Returning Officer outside office hours.
